

# **First Reading**

Proverbs 17:15-22

<sup>15</sup> He who justifies the wicked and he who condemns the righteous are both alike an abomination to the LORD. <sup>16</sup> Why should a fool have money in his hand to buy wisdom when he has no sense? <sup>17</sup> A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity. <sup>18</sup> One who lacks sense gives a pledge and puts up security in the presence of his neighbor. <sup>19</sup> Whoever loves transgression loves strife; he who makes his door high seeks destruction. <sup>20</sup> A man of crooked heart does not discover good, and one with a dishonest tongue falls into calamity. <sup>21</sup> He who sires a fool gets himself sorrow, and the father of a fool has no joy. <sup>22</sup> A joyful heart is good medicine, but a crushed spirit dries up the bones.








#### **Post-Communion Collect**
