AS WE GATHER

This is the Red Letter Challenge week of SERVING. Ephesians 2:8-9 are so clear as to how we are saved: "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast." But verse 10 continues to share with us why we were created: "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." It may be counter-culture to understand that with Jesus, the ones that are blessed are the ones who serve others and put others before themselves, but that's what we have been called and created to do. May you this week, through what you do, what you say, and how you live point people to a real relationship with God.

Pastor:


Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for us and for His sake
