
The Divine Service

Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for us and for His sake


forgives us all our sins. As a called and ordained minister of the Church of Christ, and by His authority, I therefore declare to you the entire forgiveness of all your


lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever! POST-COMMUNION COLLECT




